

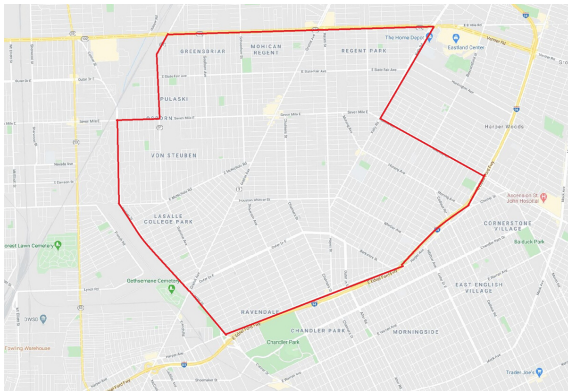

WHERE IS CAMP RESTORE DETROIT?

We are located at Mt. Calvary Lutheran Church on the corner of Chalmers and Seymour on Detroit's east side. Our address is 17100 Chalmers St. Detroit, MI 48205.



WHERE WILL WE SERVE?

The neighborhood around Camp Restore Detroit is only about 20% populated with many vacant lots and unoccupied houses. We keep our service projects within the 9th Precinct of Detroit (primarily the 48205 zip code) because this is our immediate community. We also have a wonderful partnership with the police department and many of the community leaders in our neighborhood! Campers are matched with projects that best use their abilities and interests!

ARE MEALS PROVIDED?

Meals are provided by Camp Restore Detroit. Breakfast and dinner are eaten on our campus in the dining hall. Lunches are assembled by campers in the mornings to take to their work sites. Campers are asked to help with all meals. Mt. Calvary members and community members are invited to join campers for dinner every night to share their stories and get to know campers!



WHERE WILL WE SLEEP?

Your team will sleep on the second floor of Camp Restore Detroit, where former classrooms have been converted into dorm rooms. Organizations have donated bunk beds and mattresses. Campers need to bring bedding for a twin mattress and a pillow.

There are beds for 120 campers. If your group is larger than this, please send us an email at detroit@camprestore.org to see what additional accommodations can be made.

ARE THERE SHOWERS?

Yes! Depending on how many campers are on campus we can also use the showers at a local community center.



WHAT WILL MY TEAM DO IN THE EVENINGS?

There is a full size gym with basketballs, soccer balls, footballs and more available for campers. Campers can also use the playground and large grassy area outside. The dining hall or camper lounge is a great place to play games or relax. Campers can also use the conference room or sanctuary for Bible studies or leader meetings. Wi-Fi is available throughout most of the building.

WHAT IS THE CHARGE PER CAMPER?

The charge is \$40 per camper per night. Most groups stay Sunday afternoon through Saturday morning. There is no charge for day groups.
